

POST HIGH SCHOOL CAREER SUPPORT CONTRACT

Dear Caregiver/Parent,

This contract is designed to create an open line of communication and clear expectations between you and your child regarding life together after they have graduated High School.

The goal is to help your child transition to living independently in a way that supports them as they learn and grow, while maintaining health family boundaries and clear expectations.

▶ **You probably find yourself in one of two situations:**

1 Your child is living in your home while attending College with no clear rules in place.

Expect the conversation to be a bit tougher here. They will feel you are setting the ground rules after the game has begun. Admit that you made a mistake (we all do) and that because you care about them and your relationship with them, that is why you are doing this.

2 You have a child about to graduate from High School.

GOOD NEWS! There is no better time to set expectations and get on the same page than the present moment. During this exciting time of transition, this agreement will set the tone for the years to come.

▶ **Edit the contract as needed to make it your own.**

Encourage your now adult child to ask questions. Be open and honest about the uncertainty and newness of this stage of life... and don't be afraid to share some laughs and even tears along the way!
